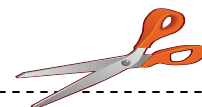

Driving Directions

From Northern Kentucky:

Take I-71 South to Exit 5, Merge onto I264 West via Exit 5 on the LEFT. Go 10.4 miles to Exit 12. Take I-65 South Nashville ramp. Go South on I-65 for 2.9 miles. Take Fern Valley Road Exit 128. Turn LEFT onto Fern Valley Road. Go 0.9 miles and Turn LEFT at traffic signal.

From Eastern Kentucky:

Take I-64 West to Exit 14 (I-264). Take I-264 West to Exit 12. Take I-65 South Nashville ramp. Go South on I-65 for 2.9 miles. Take Fern Valley Road Exit 128. Turn LEFT onto Fern Valley Road. Go 0.9 miles and turn LEFT at traffic signal.

From Western Kentucky:

Take Western Kentucky Parkway to Elizabethtown. Merge onto I-65 North via Exit 137B and drive north to Louisville. Take Exit 128. Turn RIGHT onto Fern Valley Road. Immediately get into LEFT turn lane and turn LEFT at traffic signal.
