EXEMPLIFICATION FEE:

The fee, set by the Supreme Council, for Fourth Degree Candidates is \$70.00. The fee includes a social baldric, lapel pin and one banquet ticket (whether you come to the banquet or not). It does not include hotel accommodations. There is no exemplification fee for Priests but it is requested that their Council or Assembly pay for his banquet ticket. This fee does not include the yearly dues payable to your assembly.

Lunch (optional) for the candidates will be at 11:30 a.m. There will be a \$5 fee, payable on registration form.

ATTIRE:

Candidates and Sir Knights must wear a black tuxedo, black bow tie and cummerbund, plain white pleated front shirt with a lay-down collar (no wing collars, frills or color – see picture), black socks and shoes. This attire is required at the Exemplification, Mass and Banquet. Candidates will not wear white gloves or tuxedos with tails.



Priests and Deacons may wear their clerical attire. Military Candidates may wear their full dress uniform in lieu of tuxedo. Police, Firefighters, and Emergency Medical Technician Candidates may wear their dress uniform. Sir Knights must wear Tuxedo Regalia for the Exemplification, Mass and Banquet. In addition, the social baldric and jewel of their current Council or Assembly office, or Miniature Jewel(s) should be worn.

HONOR GUARD/COLOR CORPS:

Honor Guard and Color Corps will be under the direction of District Marshal Kevin Huber. Sir Knights possessing Color Corps regalia may dress for the Mass procession. Faithful Navigators, Past Faithful Navigators, Masters and Former Masters, Vice Supreme Masters and Former Vice-Supreme Masters and Color Corps Commanders may wear the regalia of their current, past or former office.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS:

A block of rooms has been set aside for this exemplification at Quality Inn & Suites, 1805 Airport Exchange Blvd, Erlanger, Kentucky. Each individual is responsible for making his own room reservation directly with the hotel. Reservations must be made by April 14, 2017.
