
- Her Future Pregnant and Parenting Scholarship Fund: Supporting moms to choose life and continue their education. The gift of a child should never prevent someone from completing their education.

Our goal is to have one Baby Box in every Kentucky county, saving lives one box at a time. Thanks to the Kentucky General Assembly, once the new laws go into effect in July, we will be working to produce and purchase Safe Haven BB Posters with the 800#, to be installed in every Kentucky high school!
- ProLife Generation Legacy Scholarship: Providing scholarships for Kentucky high school seniors, ensuring the next generation carries forward the pro-life mission. This year we awarded ten \$1,000 ProLife Scholarships. Next year we are hoping to award twelve and send our top recipients to the National Competition and Students for Life event.
- Pulse Changing Hearts Media Outreach Ministry: Combating the lies and misleading media of the abortion industry is incredibly expensive, but this is where we can have a major impact. We focus on media, radio, and producing high-quality content with real-life-affirming Kentuckians as part of educational outreach to save lives and love both mothers and their children. We plan to expand our "Wednesdays for Women" radio show and podcast.

What is a Safe Haven Baby Box?

A Baby Box is a safety device provided under state's Safe Haven Law and legally permits a mother in crisis to safely, securely, and anonymously surrender if they are unable to care for their newborn. A Baby Box is installed in an exterior wall of a designated fire station or hospital. It has an exterior door that automatically locks upon placement of a newborn inside the Baby Box, and an interior door which allows a medical staff member to secure the surrendered newborn from inside the designated building.

On June 8th, Kentucky's 18th Safe Haven Baby Box was installed in Hebron, Kentucky! Only 102 more to go to have at least one Safe Haven Baby Box in every county!

Because our children are the most valuable and fragile among us, we are addressing the critical issue of infant abandonment and creating a safe and secure opportunity for mothers or families who find they just cannot care for their newborn. Kentucky passed the first Safe Infant Act in 2002, providing guidelines for abandoned infants in our Commonwealth. In 2022, Kentucky Right to Life supported Representative Tate, who championed the passage of HB155, the Safe Haven Baby Box Bill, which addressed this critical issue. A baby box is a safety device provided under Kentucky's Safe Haven Law and legally permits a mother in crisis to safely, securely, and anonymously surrender the infant if they are unable to care for their child. A baby box is installed on the exterior wall of a designated fire station or hospital. It has an exterior door that automatically locks upon placement of a newborn inside the baby box and an interior door that allows a medical staff member to secure the surrendered newborn from inside the designated building. In the days ahead, with Kentucky women not having abortions as an option for an unplanned or untimed pregnancy, we will see Safe Haven Baby Boxes becoming the rescue chocolate for infants.

Safe Haven Baby Boxes

Here is the process to get a Safe Haven Baby Box in a community.

- Contact Safe Haven Baby Boxes, Inc. (email: <u>shbb@SafeHavenBabyBoxes.com</u>, web & USPS below) to make them aware of your interest in procuring a Baby Box for your community. They can confirm if your state follows their standard procedure or requires additional steps.
- Meet with community leaders, fire station, or hospital administration to review the Safe Haven Baby Box Program.
- 2. The contract for SHBB is reviewed by an attorney and fundraising begins.
- The contract (Lease and Service Agreement) is signed with location and initial fee is sent to SHBB.
- 4. The Baby Box order is placed and approximately 4 weeks later the box is produced. During this production time the location will search for a licensed contractor to install the box and an alarm system company.
- 5. The Baby Box is delivered and installed by a licensed contractor.
- 6. The Alarm is set up and tested. It must reach 7 successful days of consecutive testing.
- 7. Training for the Safe Haven Baby Box will be provided by trained personnel.
- 8. The Baby Box Unveiling and Blessing occurs.
- 9. The Baby Box goes live and is available to aid infants with parents in crisis.

The costs involved in acquiring a Safe Haven Baby Box, have it installed with annual maintenance fees included are, Initial Fee: \$11,000, FEES NOT INCLUDED IN INITIAL FEE: (Estimated at \$5,000-\$7,500), and an Annual Fee of \$300.

Initial Fee: \$11,000

1. "Pre-installation" Services:

- a. Examination of location
- b. Administrative/Legal resources
- c. Consultation on programs
- d. Assistance with raising funds to support the cost of the box (optional)

2. Installation Services:

- a. Inspection of installation
- b. Training to all emergency personnel

3. Post Installation Services:

- a. Marketing of the box
- b. 24/7 hotline available to the community
- c. Advertising of the box

d. Efforts to support raising awareness on a local, state, and national level supporting the box in each community

Annual Fee: \$300 Annual Fee Services a. Recertification of the box by a licensed contractor b. Maintenance of box from expected use c. Unlimited repairs and parts replacement because of a malfunction and not as a result of negligence or vandalism.

OTHER FEES NOT INCLUDED IN INITIAL FEE: (Estimated at \$5,000-\$7,500) *Fees vary based on location and/or services donated by local community members. The below items are estimates and not a guarantee of cost.

- 1. Delivery: \$500.00 if you would like to have the box delivered. You can pick up at our Fort Wayne IN manufacturing facility to waive the delivery charge. (Must be pre-scheduled)
- 2. Installation: Labor and materials~\$2,000-\$3,500 (Location may be able to get this donated)
- 3. Electrical and Alarm: hook up to internal alarm system (Internal alarm must go to 911 dispatch for use with the baby box) ~\$1,200
- 4. Annual Alarm Service: Annual fee for monitoring~\$300 annually paid by location to Alarm Company
- 5. Transportation: Cost based on location and transportation from Indiana.
- 6. Permits or other requirements prior to construction. (varies)

The raising of money for the Boxes could be patterned after the same principle as the Ultrasound Machine Program.

SHBB currently lists over 135 boxes in 8 states, 16 of those are in Kentucky. The locations of all the boxes are listed on SHBB's website (https://shbb.org/locations). Current count is 19 babies placed in their boxes since 2017. They have also helped 121 women to conduct a safe surrender though their hotline.

Safe Haven Baby Boxes mission is to prevent illegal abandonment of newborns by raising awareness, offering a 24-hour hotline for mothers in crisis and offering the Safe Haven Baby Boxes as a last resort option for women who want to maintain complete anonymity.





The Knights of Columbus works together as an organization to purchase ultrasound machines for qualifying pregnancy centers. Discounted prices for select machines are offered through preferred pricing agreements arranged by the Supreme Council. The list of preferred machines is provided to sponsoring councils after the pregnancy center is approved for funding by the local diocese and the Supreme Council. After the state and/or local council raises 50% of the cost, the Knights of Columbus Supreme Council will provide the other 50% to complete funding for purchase of an ultrasound. Or, if the council raises 100% of the cost of a vehicle outfitted to serve as a mobile medical unit for a pregnancy center, the Supreme Council will provide 100% of the funds for an ultrasound machine to be used in that
