
Day 1

Day 6

Day 1

For those thinking of entering the seminary, that God will give them the courage to try it out, let us pray



Day 2

For perseverance for those in the seminary, especially during tough times like during exams or when they are lonely, let us pray



SECOND WEEK: PRIESTS



Day 3

For the newly ordained priests, that they may continue to learn their job even while doing it—and get the spiritual and moral support that they need, let us pray



Day 4

For those priests in their first parish alone as pastor or administrator, that they might have confidence in themselves, trust in God, and the humility to ask questions, let us pray

Day 5

For priests in very busy parishes who have no time to rest, and for priests in isolated places who wonder if anyone knows or cares about them, let us pray

Day 6

For aging and retired priests who wonder if they still have any worth or value, let us pray



Day 7

For priests undergoing persecution, either by hostile groups in their area (like terrorists or gangs) or by an anti-Catholic government, and for those facing false accusations, let us pray.
