EXEMPLIFICATION FEE:

The fee for Fourth Degree Candidates and Deacons is \$50.00. The fee includes a lapel pin and one meal ticket. There is no exemplification fee for Priests, and their meal is included at no charge. This fee does not include the yearly dues payable to your assembly.

MEAL TICKETS:

One meal is included with each Candidate/Deacon initiation fee. Additional meal tickets for family members, guests, and Sir Knights are \$6.00 each.

ATTIRE:

Candidates and Sir Knights must wear a Dark Suit (Black or Navy Blue), Plain White Dress Shirt - Button cuff (no French cuffs - no button down collar shirts), Conservative Necktie, Black Socks and plain Black Shoes. The uniform is to be worn as you would a business suit.

Priests and Deacons may wear their clerical attire. Military Candidates may wear their full dress uniform. Police, Firefighters, and Emergency Medical Technician Candidates may wear their dress uniform.

Color Corps must wear the uniform or black tuxedo, black bow tie and cummerbund, plain white pleated front shirt with a lay-down collar (no wing collars, frills or color), black socks and black shoes. When the tuxedo is worn, the social baldric is to be included.

Faithful Navigators, Past Faithful Navigators, Former Masters, Former Vice-Supreme Masters and Color Corps Commanders may wear the uniform of their current, past or former office, including the jewel of their current Council or Assembly office, or Miniature Jewel(s) should be worn.

HONOR GUARD/COLOR CORPS:

Honor Guard and Color Corps will be under the direction of District Marshal Mike Kuchenbrod. Color Corps Practice for the Exemplification will take place on Sunday, October 11th at 11:00 a.m. Formation for Dignitaries and new Sir Knights will be at 11:30 a.m.

Friends and family members are encouraged to attend the exemplification to witness their candidate go through the exemplification. We will be using the new 4th Degree Exemplification format.
