### EXEMPLIFICATION FEE:

The fee, set by the Supreme Council, for Fourth Degree Candidates and Deacons is \$70.00. The fee includes a social baldric, lapel pin and one luncheon ticket (whether you attend the luncheon or not). There is no exemplification fee for Priests but it is requested that their Council or Assembly pay for his luncheon ticket. This fee does not include the yearly dues payable to your assembly.

### LUNCHEON TICKETS:

Tickets for the Luncheon are \$20 if purchased by June 10. Tickets purchased after that day or at the door will be \$25.

### ATTIRE: **\*\*PLEASE READ - NEW UNIFORM\*\***

Candidates and Sir Knights must wear a Dark Suit (Black or Navy Blue), Plain White Dress Shirt – Button cuff (no French cuffs – no button down collar shirts), Conservative Necktie, Black Socks and plain Black Shoes. The new uniform is to be worn as you would a business suit.

Priests and Deacons may wear their clerical attire. Military Candidates may wear their full dress uniform. Police, Firefighters, and Emergency Medical Technician Candidates may wear their dress uniform.

Color Corps and File Leaders must wear the new uniform or black tuxedo, black bow tie and cummerbund, plain white pleated front shirt with a lay-down collar (no wing collars, frills or color), black socks and black shoes with the respective regalia. While the preference is for the new uniform wherever possible, the old regalia can still be worn until June 30, 2019. After that date, only the new uniform should be worn.

Faithful Navigators, Past Faithful Navigators, Former Masters, Former Vice-Supreme Masters and Color Corps Commanders may wear the regalia of their current, past or former office, including the jewel of their current Council or Assembly office, or Miniature Jewel(s) should be worn.
